



**Production Area:**

The hills between the city of Marsala and Agrigento in western Sicily.

**Grapes:**

A wine made from a typical Sicilian grape: Nero d'Avola.

**Colour:**

Deep red with purple glints.

**Bouquet:**

Scents of blackberries and cherries with light notes of almonds.

**Taste:**

The light drying of the grapes makes this wine really appealing.

**Service:**

At room temperature but in summer it is recommended to chill the bottle for a few minutes before enjoying it.

**Food Suggestions:**

Red meats, game and seasoned cheese.
